

## CARING FOR YOUR CLOWN TREE FROG

Scientific Name: *Hyla leucophyllata*  
Native to: *Central America*  
Maximum Length: *3/4" of an inch*  
Life Span: *5 years*



### CHARACTERISTICS:

When these frogs are maintained properly, they are truly hearty in captivity. They live at least four to five years in captivity, and they will fill the area around them with their loud vocalizations at night.

### CARE TIPS:

**Enclosure:** These communal frogs can live with multiple cage mates in a 10 to 20 gallon terrarium. It's also important to provide many different areas for climbing.

**Substrate:** In the past we've kept our frogs on cypress mulch, but over the years we have found that coconut husk works better. It holds moisture well, smells better, and has less problems with unwanted growth.

**Habitat:** These beautiful frogs are very communal.

**Temperature and Lighting:** 75 to 82F degrees.

**Food and Water:** Calcium supplemented insects should make up the diet. A small water dish should always be available as well as daily misting. The majority of the time your frog will drink the water droplets formed on the cage furniture rather than the water dish. However, it is still important to provide a shallow water dish.
